

# ACBLScore Special Games Instructions for Club Managers

- See below for ACBLScore instructions for setting up various types of special games.

1. ***Unit Club Championships*** (held throughout the year according to our [Special Games Schedule](#)).
  - a. Select #4, District/Unit Game
  - b. Select #1, Unit Championship (**NOT UNIT WIDE**)
  - c. Select #1, Championship Rating
  - d. Type in the above sanction number corresponding to your club in the Sanction box (listed in the [Special Games Schedule](#)).
2. ***Unit Charity Championships*** (held in December according to our [Special Games Schedule](#)).
  - a. Select #4, District/Unit Game
  - b. Select #4, Unit Charity
  - c. Type in the above sanction number corresponding to your club in the Sanction box (listed in the [Special Games Schedule](#)).
3. ***Fund Games*** (see [2026 Face-to-Face Special Event Schedule](#) for which fund games may be offered in which months).
  - a. Select #3, District/Unit Game
  - b. Select the number associated with the appropriate fund.
4. ***Glitter Games*** (see [2026 Face-to-Face Special Event Schedule](#) for glitter games schedule (look for "Go Local!"). Set up the game as a regular club game. Pigmented points will automatically be applied when you upload the gamefile to ACBLScore.

5. **FTF Stardust Weeks** (see [2026 Face-to-Face Special Event Schedule](#) for FTF Stardust Week schedule). Set up as regular games, but modify the game title field to include +GOLD+.
  
6. **North American Pairs (NAP) games** (June, July and August).
  - a. Be sure to use the required strata.
  - b. Select #5, North American Pairs or Teams
  - c. Select #1, North American Pairs - Club Level
  
7. **Grand National Team (GNT) games** (October, November, December, January and February. Frequency determined by district).
  - a. Be sure to use the required strata.
  - b. Select #5, North American Pairs or Teams
  - c. Select #3, Grand National Teams - Club Level
  
8. **April: Charity Month** you must hold as many ACBL Charity games as Local Charity Games (you may not hold more Local Charity games than ACBL Charity Games).
  - a. Select #3 Fund (Charity, International, Junior, etc)
  - b. Select #1 Charity Club Championship
  - c. Associate with your club sanction number
  - d. NOTE: to make this a local charity game, you must open your Manager page in MyACBL.org, go to your payment page and remove the table fee and make the amount to ACBL \$0. They will ask you the name of the Local charity which you must type in. Then you would write a check to the local charity.
  
9. **October: Jane Johnson Club Appreciation Month.** You may hold two club appreciation games per sanctioned session at no additional cost, either pair or team games. Pair games pay 100% sectionally rated black points; team games pay 5% gold to a maximum of 0.25 for winners and the remaining black at 100% sectional rating.
  - a. Select #2, Club Championship (ALL) / Club Appreciation
  - b. Select #6 for a pairs game or #7 for a team game.
  
10. **Club Championship Games.** You may hold two regular Club Championship games per quarter per sanctioned session.
  - a. Select #2, Club Championship (ALL) / Club Appreciation
  - b. Select #1, Regular Club Championship.
